Hope Lutheran School is operated by Hope Lutheran Church to assist its members and community members in the spiritual and academic education of their children. To make this available to its members and the community, Hope Lutheran Church subsidizes the program.

The cost to educate one child at Hope Lutheran School for the school year 2016-2017 was \$10,783. Hope Lutheran Church subsidizes 69% of a member's tuition and 51% of non-member's tuition. We are blessed to have a congregation that believes Christian education is important that will continue to support the Ministry of Hope Lutheran School.

School families that belong to Hope Lutheran Church are expected to maintain regular worship attendance and support church ministries through regular offerings according to each person's ability to contribute financially. As a member of Hope congregation, it is assumed that your offerings will help the congregation to subsidize the difference between member and non-member tuition. Families that do not maintain regular church attendance may be placed in the inactive membership status. If this occurs, non-members tuition rates will be applied.

We want to encourage your participation with the church family and to prayerfully consider your offerings to Hope Lutheran Church as we enter next school year 2017-2018.
