Why Student Council at Hope Lutheran School?

PURPOSE

The purpose of Student Council shall be:

- 1. To foster Christian cooperation among students and faculty.
- 2. To promote and encourage activities for the best interest of the school.
- 3. To develop good citizens and leaders through experience in government.
- 4. To provide a means for student expression.
- 5. To encourage student involvement.

All members of Student Council will:

- Make recommendations for anything of student concern in the building.
- Be responsible for student publicity to promote student council activities such as dances and fundraisers.
- Attend meetings at 7:30 am on third Friday of the month. The council will meet more often at the discretion of the president or advisor (Mrs. Jankowski will serve as faculty advisor this year)
- Sponsor two fundraisers, for example Christmas Jingle Grams, Valentine Grams
- Cooperate with faculty or advisor to perform tasks.
- Organize two dances for middle school students (FALL for 6th-8th and SPRING for 5th-8th).
- Be responsible for leading a chapel service as a group.
- Be responsible for special occasions (presidential elections in November and See You At the Pole – September 28th); Student Council will promote and lead the student body during these several occasions and future events.
