UPDATED SKATING PARTY TONIGHT! — PTL is hosting a skating party tonight, October 21st from 5:00—7:00 pm. ATM MACHINE AT HOPE— The Board of Christian Education has provided a ATM machine, located in the Commons Area of the school, for church/school families as well as visitors to the facility. We have found that many people today do not carry cash or checks so we wanted to provide this service. The ATM machine is available while the church or school is open. We have a cover on the machine so all you need to do is lift the cover, process your transaction and then please recover the machine. There is a \$2.00 service charge so for an example if you need \$20.00 your account will show the transaction as \$22 dollars. The maximum daily withdrawal is \$200.00.
