THE REPROACHES

The Reproaches, or Improperia, are a series of remonstrances of Christ with His people. The Church responds with pleas for mercy. As part of the liturgy, they date back to the ninth century. The text is based on Micah 6:3–4; Jeremiah 2:6–7; and Isaiah 5:2–4.

FIRST REPROACH

- Thus says the Lord: What have I done to you, O My people, and wherein have I offended you? Answer Me. For I have raised you up out of the prison house of sin and death, and you have delivered up your Redeemer to be scourged. For I have redeemed you from the house of bondage, and you have nailed your Savior to the cross. O My people.
- A Holy Lord God, holy and mighty God, holy and most merciful Redeemer; God eternal, leave us not to bitter death. O Lord, have mercy.
