Beloved in the Lord, Christ our Lord commended the giving of gifts of mercy to the poor and to those in need, saying, “Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

P St. John the Evangelist says of Jesus, the Word and the Christ:
